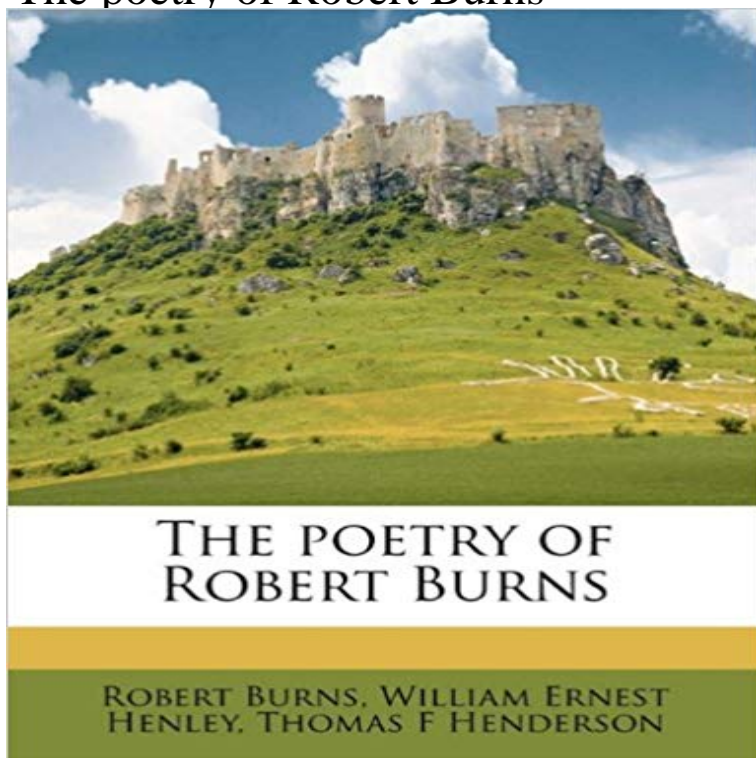


The poetry of Robert Burns
