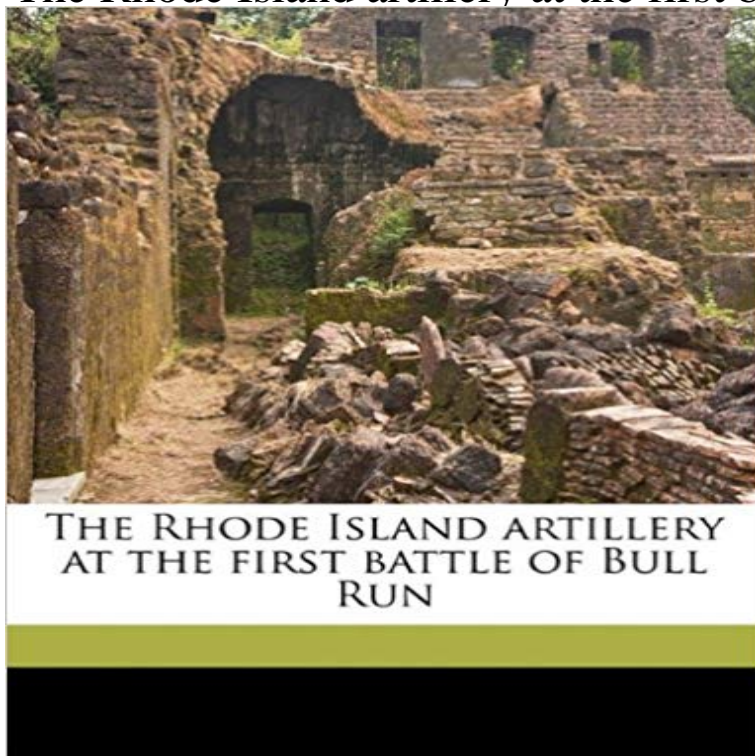


## The Rhode Island artillery at the first battle of Bull Run
