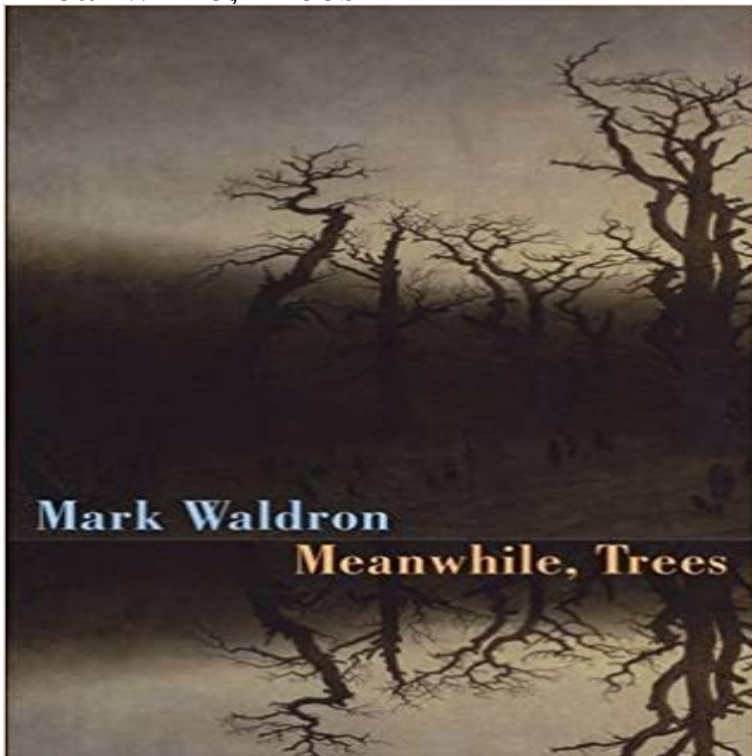


Meanwhile, Trees
