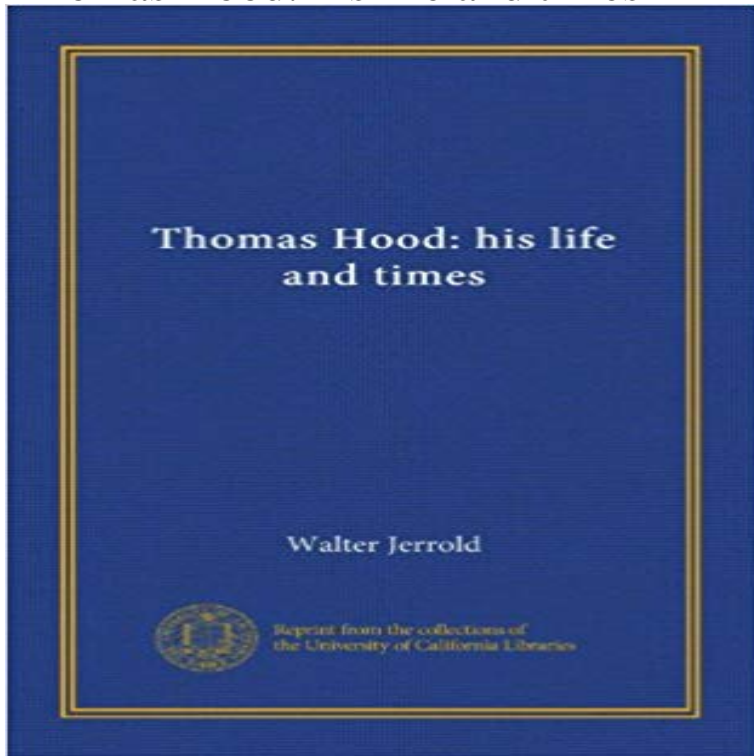


Thomas Hood: his life and times
