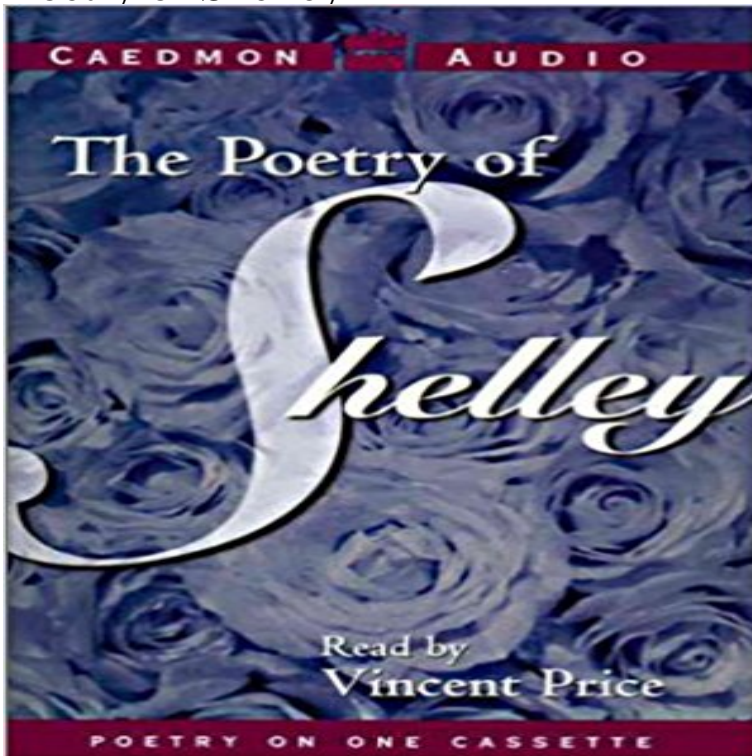


Poetry of Shelley
