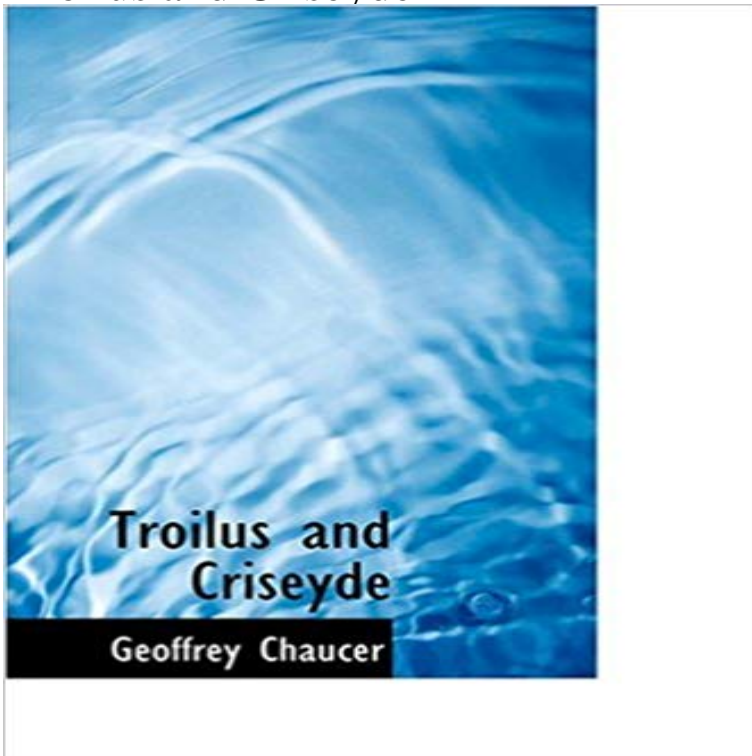


Troilus and Criseyde
