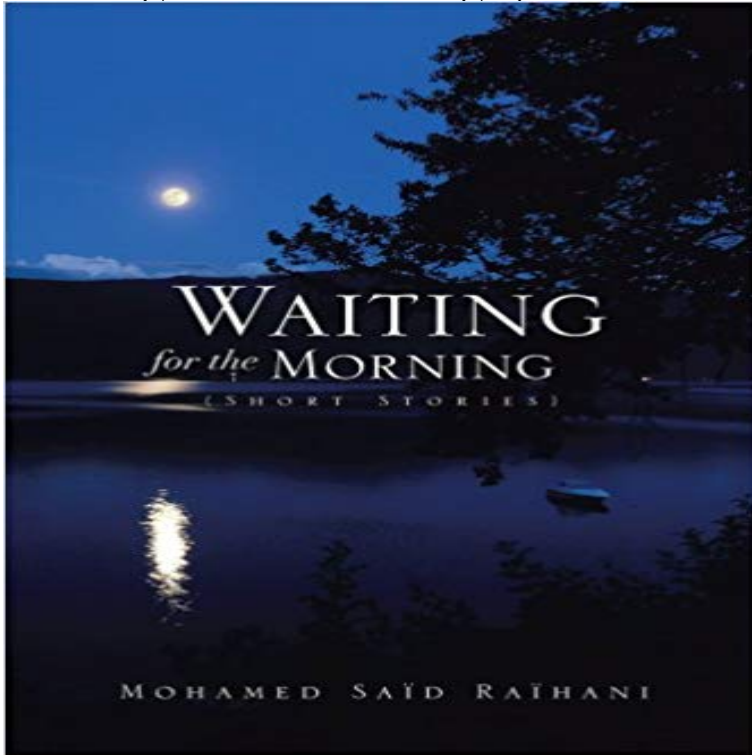


Waiting for the Morning: (Short Stories)
