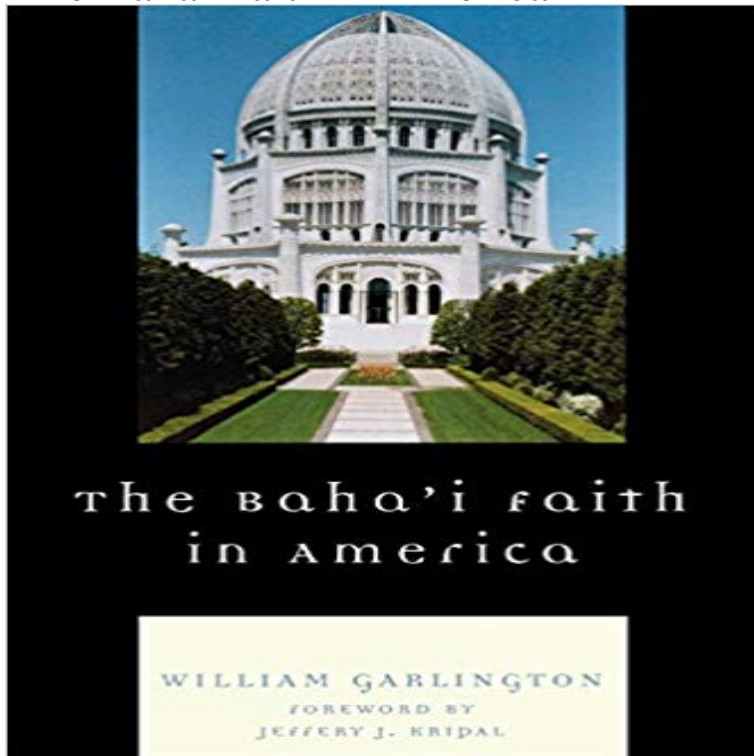


The Bahai Faith in America
