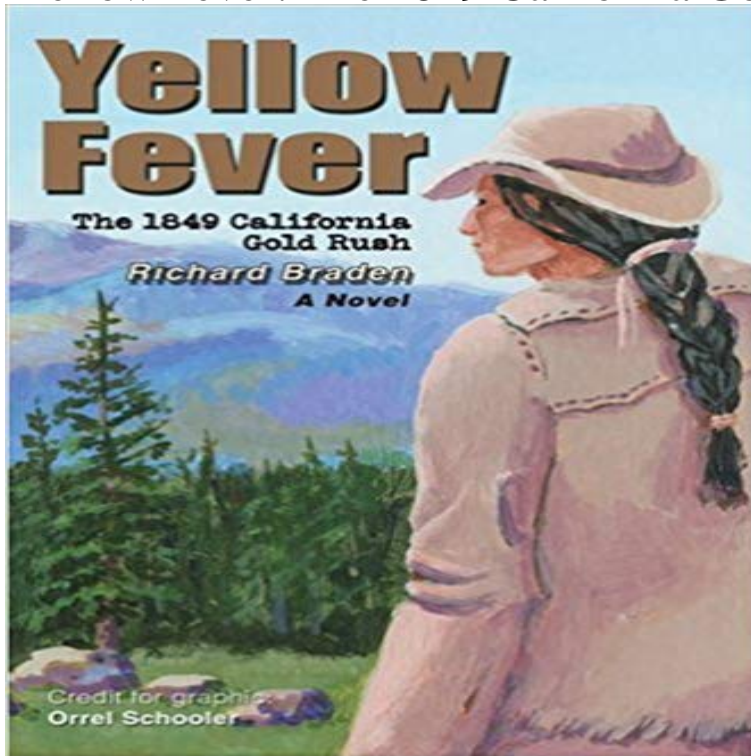


Yellow Fever: The 1849 California Gold Rush
